Sean has conducted recordings and concerts for leading Australian orchestras including the Adelaide Symphony, the Queensland Orchestra, West Australian Symphony Orchestra, Tasmanian Symphony and Orchestra Victoria.

His compositions have been performed by all the major Australian Orchestras and by North American Orchestras such as the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra. He has written and produced music for more than 60 CDs recorded in collaboration with the ABC with artists such as Yvonne Kenny and Judi Connelly.

His orchestral concert projects include Symphonic Swing with James Morrison, Tommy Emmanuel, The Whitlams, *George Meets the Orchestra* with George Spartels, Monica Trapega Family Concerts and *Dreams are Forever* with Riley Lee. Festival, music direction and major events include Warner Brothers Movie World, Encore (Townsville) Old Biennial Festival of Music, Brisbane Riverfestival-Riversymphony & Riversymposium, Centenary of Federation (Townsville), Cloudland (Queensland Ballet). Sean composed the ABC Sydney 2000 Olympic theme also used in Manchester for the 2002 Commonwealth Games.

Soloist : James Morrison

At the age of 16 James debuted in the USA at the Monterey Jazz Festival. Performances followed at



the big festivals in Europe and James played with jazz legends such as Dizzy Gillespie, B.B King and Wynton Marsalis to name just a few. A multi instrumentalist, James plays trombone, flugelhorn, euphonium, tuba, saxophones, piano, and of course the trumpet.

His career is diverse. A few highlights: James has recorded "Jazz meets the Symphony" with the London Symphony Orchestra, performed concerts with the London Philharmonic, played gigs in the world's top jazz clubs and played for the World's Heads of State. In 1997 James was awarded the Order of Australia for his

service to the Arts.

He spends much time in education, runs master classes and workshops and a jazz scholarship as well as heading up Morrison Records, an independent label dedicated to the best of jazz. James writes film scores, composes, and is patron of several youth orchestras. In his spare time (?) he enjoys flying his private plane, rally driving, abseiling and triathlons. When asked "What is there left to do?" his reply is typically exciting "This is just the warm up!"

Vocalist : Emma Pask

First discovered by James Morrison as a schoolgirl, Emma has gone on to forge an impressive career including being a regular vocalist with James Morrison's Band, winning a Mo Award for Jazz Vocalist, Performer of the Year in 2005 and singing for the Kidman/Urban nuptials!



Emma has been a regular guest on national TV shows like the 'Midday Show', 'Good Morning Australia', the 'Today Show', and she has also sung to VIP audiences including the late Diana, Princess of Wales, and the Prime Minister of Australia.

She has performed to audiences of up to 50,000, and sung with jazz legend Don Burrows, Christine Anu, Iva Davies, Jimmy Barnes, the NZ Philharmonic, Barbara Morrison, the WA Symphony Orchestra, at the Phillips International Jazz Festival, the Myer Music Bowl in Melbourne, in Cape Town with the Darius Brubeck Trio, and following the enormous success of her first album, has just released her second CD "This Madness Called Love".
